

## Räägi ühest ilusast kohast Eestis!

Tell about a beautiful place in Estonia!

**Martin:** See koht, millest ma tahtsin rääkida, on Võsu. Võsuga on selline lugu, et minu vanematel on seal suvila. Võsu on üks rannaküla, mis asub Lahemaal, Põhja-Eestis. Võsu on niisugune küla, kus on hästi ilus liivarand ja selle liivaranna juures on hästi palju suvilaid, väiksemaid majakesi, kus inimesed käivad suvel. Talvel on seal väga vaikne, püsielanikke on vähe. Aga suvel on seal väga tore jalutada. Seal on päris palju meelelahutust: seal on mitu restorani, seal on üks ööklubi. Seal toimub rannafestival, randa pannakse üles suur lava ja inimesed kogunevad ja kuulavad muusikat. Võsul suvel elu käib!

This place that I wanted to talk about is Võsu. The story with Võsu is that my parents have a cottage there. Võsu is a seaside village, which is located in Lahemaa, in northern Estonia. Võsu is the sort of village where there is a very beautiful sandy beach, and in the vicinity of this sandy beach are a lot of cottages, smaller houses, where people go during summer. In winter it is very quiet there, permanent inhabitants are few. But during summer it is very nice to walk there. There are quite a lot of amusements: there are several restaurants, there is a nightclub. A beach festival happens there, a big stage is built on the beach, and people come together to hear music. **Anastassia:** Sõrve saar on üks väga kaunis koht. Sa oled seal nagu maailma lõpus! Seal saavad kokku maa ja meri. See on väga romantiline koht ja seal on ka, mida vaadata. The peninsula of Sõrve is a beautiful place. It's like you are at the end of the world there. It's where the land and sea come together. It is a very romantic place, and there is lots to see there. There is a lighthouse and one can enjoy the beautiful and endless sea view. I really recommend everyone to go there. Actually, we only got the so-called free use of this area when Estonia became free. Previously there were military bases there, and now there are endless ocean views, where you can feel yourself completely free.

**Martin:** Hüva, ühesõnaga on olemas selline tore koht nagu Tartu. Tartu on minu jaoks oluline sellepärast, et ma käisin seal ülikoolis. Tartus on imekaunis kesklinn. Tartus on Toomemägi, kus saab jalutada, kus soojal ajal on võimalik mõnes kohas muru peal piknikku pidada. Ja lisaks sellele asub Tartus ka näiteks AHHA-keskus, mis on niisugune teaduse populariseerimise asutus, kus nii suured kui ka lapsed saavad avastada teadust. Ja kuna Tartu on päris palju Tallinnast lõuna pool, siis kevadel Tartusse minnes on lehed seal ikka palju

varem rohelised kui Tallinnas. Niimoodi saab ka väikeses Eestis liikuda ühest kliimavöötimest teise.

All right, in a word, there is such a nice place as Tartu. Tartu is important for me because I went to university there. In Tartu there is a very beautiful town centre. Toomemägi is in Tartu, where one can go walking, where during warm weather one can sit on the grass and have a picnic in certain spots. And in addition to this, for example, there is the AHHAA-centre, which is a kind of science popularisation place, where both adults and children can go to discover science. And since Tartu is still pretty far south from Tallinn, then when going to Tartu in the spring the leaves turn green much earlier than in Tallinn. In this way one can also move from one climate zone to another in little Estonia.
